On 09/04/2014 at 1310 hours, your affiant had the occasion to investigate a homicide of four individuals which occurred at 7719 Hatteras Drive in Hudson, FL 34667. The incident location is a two-story, single-family residence which is located on the northwest corner of Old Dixie Highway and Hatteras Drive. The bottom level of the residence has a one car garage on the east side and a two car garage on the west side. In the rear of the bottom level is a large room with a laundry area and storage locations. There are three bedrooms and two baths upstairs with a kitchen, dining room area and living room. The victims in this case are: Gregory Brown and his wife, Margaret Brown, their daughter, Megan Brown, and her boyfriend, Nicholas Leonard. The defendant is Adam Matos who is Megan Brown's ex-boyfriend and father of Megan's 4 year old son, Ismael "Tristan" Santisteban. Everyone except Nicholas lived at the incident location as a family. Nicholas Leonard lives at 12721 Woodchuck Way in Hudson FL 34667. Your affiant spoke to numerous people who stated the following:

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

On 09/04/2014 at 0954 hours Linda Thomas contacted the Pasco County Sheriff's Office requesting a welfare check on step-daughter, Margaret Brown. Linda advised she hadn't been able to contact Margaret since 08/28/2014. Your affiant responded to the scene after Deputies Miguel Silva and Thomas Smith discovered what appeared to be evidence of a crime scene during the welfare check. Deputy Silva reported he observed what appeared to be a spent bullet lying on the driveway in the front of the residence. Deputy Silva reported he smelled what appeared to be decomposition coming from the garage area consistent with decaying bodies. Deputy Silva reported after speaking with Linda Thomas, he discovered all of the victim's vehicles were at the location. Deputy Silva reported based on these circumstance he and Deputy Smith entered the residence to check the status of the residents. Deputy Silva reported he was unable to locate anyone inside, however, he observed what appeared to be a large amount of blood in the single-car garage behind a silver Dodge Caravan which was backed into the garage. Deputy Silva reported he observed several large rugs and blankets which appeared to be covered in blood.

Deputy Silva reported he conducted a call history at the residence and discovered an aggravated assault case was called in on 08/28/2014 at 0607 hours by Megan Brown. Deputy Frederick Heidgerken was the investigating officer of the aggravated assault case and conducted an interview with Megan Brown at 0607 hours on 08/28/2014 at the incident location. Megan reported the following during that interview: Megan came home at approximately 0530 hours and was confronted by Adam Matos about her whereabouts from the previous night and morning. Megan reported Adam pushed her against a wall and held a knife to her throat threatening to kill her. Megan reported her son woke up from the yelling and this is when Adam fled the residence.

On 09/04/2014, the four victims bodies were found by Sgt J. Babcock approximately 1 mile north of the incident location off the side of the roadway on Old Dixie Highway. I observed what was confirmed to be four human bodies lying next to and on top of each other. The bodies were in a state of decomposition and each body was covered in maggots. I observed one body to have what appeared to be a bag over the head. At this time, the whereabouts of 4 year old Ismael "Tristan" Santisteban was unknown so an Amber Alert was created and a search for him was conducted throughout the night. During the search, I learned on 09/04/2014 at 2240 hours, Adam Matos took a cab from the area of Yachtsman Drive and Bertram Drive to a Greyhound bus terminal in Tampa FL (This location is a few blocks from the incident location). Tampa Police Department discovered Adam Matos checked into a hotel a few blocks from the bus terminal.

A witness, Lamont Marshall, who is a security guard at the Greyhound bus terminal advised he spoke with the defendant on 09/05/2014 at approximately 0001 hours. Lamont said Adam walked up to the door and asked, "What time is the first bus out of here." Lamont reported he told Adam the first bus is after 0600 hours. Lamont advised he directed Adam to a local hotel. A friend of victim, Megan Brown, named Tonya Carlson, reported she spoke with Megan on 08/28/2014 at approximately 0830 hours. According to Tonya, Megan told her, Adam was acting crazy and she's never seen him act like this and he's going to kill me. Megan also told Tonya she was scared to report to work due to Megan believing Adam would take their son. Your affiant discovered the defendant made approximately 200 phone calls to the victims, Megan Brown and Margaret Brown's cell phones from 08/28/2014 at 0749 hours. The last phone call to Megan's cell phone by the defendant was on 08/28/2014 at 1613 hours.

Detective Hatcher provided the following information: On 09/04/2014 1319 hours, there were four adult bodies found; two males and two females that were badly decomposed. One of the female victims was wearing a WAWA gas station apron, her hands were bound behind her back and her head was covered with a bag. Detective Hatcher reported one of the bodies was positively identified as Nicholas Leonard by several tattoos.

Your affiant spoke with Detective W. Lindsey who confirmed Margaret Brown worked at WAWA Gas Station and left work for the last time on 08/28/2014 at approximately 2300 hours.


Your affiant spoke with Detective A. Bossone who spoke with the direct next door neighbor to the west, Ryan McCann who reported the following: Ryan spoke with Adam Matos everyday between 08/28/2014 through 09/03/2014 at the incident location and Ryan's residence. On the morning of 08/29/2014 between midnight and 0100 hours Ryan observed the defendant outside the residences and the defendant appeared out of breathe and sweating. Both on 08/29/2014 and 09/02/2014 Ryan had a conversation with the defendant about the whereabouts of the victims and Ismael Santisteban. The defendant told Ryan the family flew to West Virginia and took a cab to the airport and the defendant was home alone.

Detective W. Lindsey told your affiant Adam Matos also placed several ads on Craigslist.com to sell several items from the residence to include Margaret and Gregory's dogs. They were dog breeders and owned several dogs. The following people went to the incident location and purchased the victims dogs from the defendant: On 08/29/2014 Patrick Duarte purchased four dogs for \$50.00 each. Patrick advised Adam Matos is the male he purchased the dogs from. On 08/29/2014 Paige Steele purchased one dog for \$50.00. Paige made a positive identification of Adam Matos through a Photo Pack as the person she purchased the dog from. On 08/31/2014 Ivon Carmenate and her son, Variel Carmenate purchased one dog for \$50.00 from the defendant. Ivon reported she identified Adam through his photographs on the news. Ivon reported smelling a foul odor omitting from the incident location.

Your affiant learned on 08/29/2014 at 2348 Adam Matos purchased a long handled shovel at Walmart at 12610 US HWY 19 in Hudson FL. The shovel is made by Ames and is sold with a small sticker attached to it with the make and model information. The defendant used victim, Margaret Brown's debit card to purchase the shovel. The same make and model shovel was located in the victim, Margaret Brown's vehicle and the sticker from the shovel was located in a small fresh dug hole next to the residence.

Your affiant learned the defendant used victim, Margaret Brown's debit card to purchase two orders of food from Papa John's pizza located in Hudson FL. The first order was called in on 09/01/2014 at 1632 hours and delivered to the incident location by Erin Jacobs. Erin reported the defendant paid with victim, Margaret Brown's, debit card. Erin reported she observed Ismael Santisteban with Adam. The second order was called in on 09/02/2014 at 1722 hours and delivered to the incident location by Jesse Fletcher. Jesse reported the defendant paid in cash and he did not observe Ismael at the residence. Jesse reported he could smell a foul odor omitting from the residence.

On 09/03/2014 at 0700 hours a neighbor, Sharon Mann, reported seeing a male who matches Adam Matos' description spraying water in the garage and sweeping the water outside a side garage door.

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

Your affiant learned the victim, Megan Brown, failed to report to work on 08/29/2014 and the last person who spoke with Megan was her boss, James Sigler, on 08/28/2014 at 1509 hours. James reported Megan told him she scared and felt the defendant was going to kill her.

Your affiant learned the victim, Margaret Brown, left from her place of employment on 08/28/2014 at 2300 hours, and failed to report to work on 08/29/2014 at 1500 hours. On 08/28/2014 at 0910 hours, Deputy Heidgerken observed Megan Brown, Margaret Brown, and Gregory Brown at the incident location while following up on the aggravated assault case. On 08/28/2014 at 1430 hours, Detective J. Kraus spoke with victim, Nicholas Leonard, over the phone about an unrelated case. The four victims were not seen or heard from since 08/28/2014.


Your affiant spoke with the Deputy Chief Medical Examiner Dr. Noel Palmer on 09/11/2014 and was advised of the autopsy findings. The victim Megan Brown's cause of death was a gunshot wound to the head with a manner of death being homicide. The victim Margaret Brown's cause of death was blunt head trauma and contributory condition of asphyxiation with the manner of death being homicide. The victim Gregory Brown's cause of death was gunshot wounds to the torso with the manner of death being homicide. The victim Nicholas Leonard's cause of death was blunt force trauma to the head with the manner of death being homicide. The Medical Examiner's Office was able to positively identify the four victims.

On 09/05/2014 at approximately 0630 hours, I conducted a custodial, post-Miranda interview with the defendant who advised he was last at the incident location on 08/28/2014 at approximately 0600 hours. The defendant reported he did not return home on 08/29/2014. The defendant did not provide any further statement.

On 09/09/2014 at 1730 hours, the defendant made contact with Alex Orlando from the Tampa Bay Times after the defendant requested the interview. During the interview I heard the defendant tell Alex the last time he was at the incident location was 08/28/2014 and did not return.
